Geography

We are going to learn about why population changes. This unit is full of interesting subjects such as: Identifying the most densely and sparsely populated areas, describing the increase in global population over time and describing what might influence the environments people live in. We will also find out about migration and explain why some people have no choice but to leave their homes.

Maths

The term begins with a fraction unit in which the children will learn how to compare, order, add and subtract fractions. We will then learn the written methods of long multiplication and long division.

The children will be tested on thei<mark>r times tables on a Friday, with results coming home so you can check in their progress.</mark>

Relationships and Health Education

During the term the children will learn about internet safety. This is a really important topic as the children become more exposed to social media as they are getting older.

Science

This term we will be learning about electricity.

We will construct electrical circuits, identifying and naming its parts, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers. We will also find out about common conductors and insulators.

Art

In our art lessons, the children will explore the process of making monotypes. The pathway starts with an introduction to monotypes, and then children explore the work of an artist who uses monotypes to build sculptures and installations.

English

This term we will be writing instructions on making circuits. We will also be writing recounts about our trip to Oxford and performing poems.

GPS (Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling) and guided reading also fulfil an important role in English and these take place weekly.

Computing

The children will learn how to create short videos in groups. As they progress through this unit, they will be exposed to topic-based language and develop the skills of capturing, editing, and manipulating video.

PE

On Mondays and Thursdays, we will be learning routines for country dancing or playing dodgeball. Please can you ensure that your child has suitable indoor PE kits for both days.

Music

We will be learning songs for Young Voices. We will also be finding out about jazz music and develop improvisation skills.

R.E

We will have a series of lessons exploring why some people believe in God and some people do not.
