

Geography

Why do oceans matter?

We will be exploring the importance of our oceans and how they have changed over time with a focus on the Great Barrier Reef, specifically addressing climate change and pollution.

PSHE

This term we will focus on aspirations, work and career. We will learn about the broad range of jobs and careers that people can have and the different routes that people can take to get there.

Science

Living things and their habitats - we will describe the differences in the life cycles of mammals, amphibians and insects. We will also describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals.

ICT - Spreadsheets

This unit introduces the children to spreadsheets. They will be supported in organizing data into rows and columns to create their own data set. They will learn to apply formulas to cells and create charts.

Art - Exploring identity

We will be exploring artists that embrace the things that make them the way they are: their culture, background, experiences and passions. Then use the Mike Barrett's work to create a layered self-portrait that captures aspects of our own personalities and identities.

English

Our first unit this term is story writing using our class story 'Holes' as inspiration. We will be taking part in World Book Day and have lots of exciting activities planned. We will also be preparing for this year's Mock Trial competition. These lessons have a heavy focus on speaking and listening and the children will learn how to present an argument and conduct role play.

Maths

Y5 and Y6 children will learn about fractions, decimals and percentages and their relationship with each other. They will then learn about perimeter and area of polygons and compound shapes. Their final unit this term is on statistics.

The class will be tested on their times tables on a Friday.

RE

We are learning why the Torah is so important to Jewish people.

French

This term we will be learning the names of different hobbies and write phrases about them.

PE

This term we will practice hockey skills when dry or dodgeball or country dancing if wet. Please ensure your child has both warm outdoor clothing as well as indoor PE clothing this term.

Music
